WE ASSESS.

Our assessment can include perspectives from home and school as well as from the young person at the centre of the work.

WE INTERVENE.

We can be as involved with intervention as you need us to be. We can visit very frequently in order to work directly with a young person individually, or in a group. Alternatively, we can support your staff to deliver an intervention themselves, through training, demonstrating and coaching. We can also provide evaluation of intervention programmes, identifying with you what the goals are and how to measure progress.

WE TRAIN.

Whether you work in a school, college, University, Local Authority or other organisation, we can tailor training to your specific needs. Training may be needed to support an individual child, or it can address wider issues. Our practitioners are regularly invited to teach neuropsychology on postgraduate courses and we can bring our up-to-date knowledge to your team.

WE SPECIALISE.

Often children are well cared for if they have to go to hospital with a brain injury or neurological problem. When they return to school, it can be difficult for staff to know how best to teach and manage the child. As that young person grows up, some problems can resolve but others may emerge, necessitating support at different times throughout childhood and adolescence.

As child neuropsychologists we have specialised training and experience in understanding how brains develop and work, and how they influence behaviour. We use this knowledge to understand the impact of a child's brain injury or condition, and to promote their on-going development.

At Recolo we have developed a specialised child neuropsychology model that incorporates up-to-date research about brain development as well as support for the adults around the child. We promote the health of the physical brain through diet, exercise and rest. Injury to the brain often results in 'dysregulation', e.g. problems with organisation, planning and regulating mood or behaviour. We aim to understand the child's current pattern of development and work within the child's existing systems to prevent problems and enhance progress.
