

Person Specification: Recolo Associate Clinical Neuropsychologist / Psychologist

General Role


To provide a qualified clinical psychology and neuropsychology service to children and young people and their families referred to Recolo (children and young people with an acquired brain injury). This includes providing specialist neuropsychological assessment and intervention; providing highly specialist psychological assessment and interventions, including development and implementation of specialist psychological rehabilitation interventions, consultation, and teaching.

At the same time offering specialist advice and consultation on the children and young people's psychological care to non-psychologist colleagues and to other, non-professional carers, working autonomously within professional guidelines and the overall framework of the team's policies and procedures.

Essential criteria

1. HCPC Registered Clinical Psychologist
2. Commitment to intervention work with children who have brain injuries and their families

Desirable criteria

1. Two years post-qualification experience
 2. Experience of working in the independent sector
 3. Available to work at least one day per week
 4. Interest in/experience of neuropsychology and acquired brain injury (this may include further study or specialist skills)
 5. Experience of working with children and their families in a range of settings in the community (e.g. school, home)
 6. Experience of working with children and their families to provide interventions.
 7. Commitment to flexible, long-term work with children and their families.
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
